## Future of the Fellowship

Following the congregational meeting on 3 May, the Canterbury Fellowship committee met on 13 May and again on 1 June to discuss the future of the Fellowship. Our interim plan is to continue with morning Eucharists, with the first Sunday of the month providing a musical offering, although not the full sung Eucharist as in the past, and the customary said service on other Sunday mornings. David Macfarlane has kindly agreed to continue as organist for the first Sunday services.

An exception will be the morning service on 5 July where the choir will provide a final sung Eucharist under the direction of Matthew Thomson.

Evensong services will take place each Sunday at 6pm in June and July under the direction of Elizabeth-Anne (or as we know her, EA) with a small choir. The committee is still considering arrangements for evening services for the remainder of the year.

The committee is very grateful to David, EA, Matthew, the choristers who have made the commitment to continue with Evensong in June and July, and those who will sing at the 5 July Eucharist. This will give the Fellowship a window of time to consider how it might go forward in relation to the choral side of the Fellowship.

It is also courteous to our host, Trinity College, as it will give them an opportunity to consider what alternative arrangements they may want to make to cover the times that the college choir has not covered in the past.

A message from EA herself: my intent for these services is to keep the music as simple but as satisfying as possible - so that it will continue to be a pleasure to those who sing and to those who worship through listening. I'll look for the occasional work that is both liturgically relevant and fresh to the group - but in principle, we will sing from the Fellowship repertoire suited to smaller resources. After that wonderful celebratory sing at John's final service, these services will be aiming for a different sort of beauty through June and July!



## Farewell to John O'Donnell

The Fellowship wishes a fond farewell to Choir Director John O'Donnell, who after doing a sterling service for 30 years is moving on to a new position as Director of Music at All Saints', East St Kilda, from June 2015. Several alumni choir members returned to sing in John's final Choral Eucharist on May 24, followed by a special farewell brunch where speeches, stories, and much delicious food and drink was shared!
